In her writings, Walker defines a [womanist](#) as a \"black feminist or feminist of color.\" Walker cites the phrase [acting womanish](#), which Black mothers said to a child who willfully acted serious, courageous, and grown-up rather than [girlish](#), as generally expected by society.

Alice Walker's 1983 definition of a Womanist. 1. From womanish. (Opp. of "girlish," i.e. frivolous, irresponsible, not serious.) A black feminist or feminist of color. From the black folk expression of mothers to female children, "you acting womanish," i.e., like a woman. Usually referring to outrageous, audacious, courageous or willful behavior.

Womanism is a social theory based on the history and everyday experiences of women of color, especially black women. It seeks, according to womanist scholar Layli Maparyan, to "restore the balance between people and the environment/nature and reconcil human life with the spiritual dimension". Writer Alice Walker coined the term "womanist" in a short story, "Coming Apart", in 1979. Since Walker's initial use, the term has evolved to envelop varied, and often opposing, interpretations of conceptio
