This phenomenon is called anosognosia (a lack of knowledge or insight), and it can be a serious challenge to deal with as a caregiver for someone with Alzheimer 's or other types of dementia. Family members and caregivers must keep in mind that their afflicted loved ones are neurologically incapable of acknowledging their mental deficit and underlying illness, regardless of logical explanations or evidence.
