The court can make a number of orders to restrict their contact with animals, such as: a deprivation order - to take the animal away and stop them owning it. It may also stipulate that the animal is to be sold or destroyed; a disqualification order - stops them owning or working with animals

### How to report animal cruelty - Citizens Advice Scotland

In order to protect animals from future harm, our priority in many prosecution cases is for people who are convicted to be banned from keeping animals.\* This can only happen if a conviction is secured and the court decides that such a ban is appropriate. When a conviction is secured, the court is then able to permanently confiscate animals.

#### Prosecuting animal cruelty & neglect - Prosecutions Team ...

The courts in several countries have rejected applications to extend human rights to animals. For example, in January 2006 in New York, the New York Supreme Court declined to issues a writ of habeas corpus on behalf of Tommy the Chimpanzee, concluding that he was not entitled to the writ.
