Africa possesses established arbitration institutions, including the Cairo Regional Centre for International Commercial Arbitration (" CRCICA ") initiated in January 1979, the Lagos Regional Center (" RCICAL ") which was set up in 1989, and the Cour Commune de Justice et d ' Arbitrage (" CCJA ") in Cote d ' Ivoire established in 2001 by the OHADA.
