Transitions from attack to defence are crucial in the 4-2-3-1. Losing the ball when attacking makes the formation vulnerable as the players are out of position. The fullbacks need to call the wide forward back to help out with the defending. If they do not, the fullbacks risk being isolated and overloaded on the wing.

Set Up: There are 12-15 players set up in the attacking third, starting at the cones. Procedure: The Feeder begins the drill with a pass up to Player A. Player A plays a back pass to Player B

or Player D. As the back pass is made, Players C and E make overlapping runs down the sideline. The last pass can be played thru to either flank, and the sequence finishes with a cross and finish.
