Understanding By Design – Backwards Design Process

Backwards design focuses on the destination and then plans the route, rather than the other way around. There are three stages to the process of backwards design: Identify the desired results; Identify evidence of learning; Design the instructional plan; Stage 1 – Identify Desired Results

Backward Design is a teaching method that involves designing educational curriculum by setting goals before choosing instructional methods and forms of assessment. This teaching model lends itself very well to proficiency-based language teaching as it requires the teacher to focus on what students will ultimately be able to do with the language, rather than simply knowing about the language.

The Logic of Backward Design - ASCD

Before applying the backward design model, understanding the 7 principles and the big picture will support effective planning with clearly defined goals, aligned assessment and coherent lessons. A framework for planning curriculum, instruction, and assessment is provided in Understanding by Design (McTighe), with 2 key ideas:
