Mix ¼ cup kosher salt with 4 cups of water. Submerge the duck in the mixture and leave it overnight. If you are planning on doing a cold smoke, a long smoke or want more of a raw cook, add ½ -1 tsp. of pink salt, or sodium nitrate, to the mixture. When duck is brined, take it out of the mixture and pat dry. Then leave it out to dry for a few hours.

Hunters should be out in duck country in the evening, driving roads, and following flocks of birds into their roost. Then the next day you should come back to watch those birds lifting off and heading to their feeding areas.
