Vulnerable children and families can often face challenges with their accommodation. They may have temporary accommodation or a lack of space, for example the sharing of one room. During the COVID-19 outbreak, the exposure of children and families to unsuitable accommodation will increase as adults may work from home and members of the household are unable to be outside.
