In discourse production, Context Models take semantic information as input from episodic mental models about personal, biographical expetiences, situations, events or actions, as in storytelling (*Neisser & Fivush, 1994), or from models of social and polit ical events, such as in news discourse (*Van Dijk, 1988), or more general, 'semantic' knowledge, as in expository discomse.
