The Immigration Law provides two ways in which you can become a Permanent Resident of Costa Rica. First, you must have held a Temporary Residency category for at least three (3) years and then request the change to Permanent Residency. The other option is limited to Immediate Relative

Immigration and Residency Immigration and residency laws in Costa Rica depend on your country of nationality. Citizens of the United States, Canada and the European Union don ' t typically need a visa to enter Costa Rica, and are allowed to remain in the country for up to 90 days with a valid passport.

On many occasions you will not have to wait the 72 hours (depending on the immigration officer). Citizens who are classified as “ group two ” may enter Costa Rica without an entry Visa and may remain in Costa Rica for up to 30 days. This applies for such countries as El Salvador, Belize, Guatemala, Honduras and Venezuela.
