A dichotomous key is an important tool used by biologists to identify a given species or organism, and crop up in the GCSE biology syllabus. Dichotomous keys look like flow charts, and feature a series of images and text with two choices branching off at each step: you choose the one that fits the organism you want to identify. At each stage, you're presented with a choice of characteristics, and answer 'yes' or 'no', until you make an identification of an organism, or species.
