Epididymitis is inflammation or infection of the epididymis, which is the long tube that rests along the testicles. Epididymitis can be caused by sexually transmitted diseases, injury, a side effect from a vasectomy, and other problems.

Testicular Tumors. Testicular carcinoma represents 1% of all neoplasm in men and is the most common malignancy in the 15–34-year-old age group. 19
A second peak prevalence occurs in the 71–90-year-old age group, with metastasis and lymphoma most common. There has been an unexplained increase in the prevalence of testicular carcinoma over the last 70 years, and testicular carcinoma is predominantly a cancer of white males.

Failure of a testis to descend into the scrotum is called cryptorchidism. The testis is divided internally into about 250 compartments or lobules, each of which contains one to three small convoluted tubules, within which spermatozoa are produced.

Testicular Disorders and Infertility: Hypogonadism
Some comorbid diseases, including chronic kidney disease, coronary heart disease, diabetes, and hepatic cirrhosis, may show features such as edema/swelling and enlargement that are similar to those of acute scrotal infection, so we compared the distributions of those comorbid diseases and found no significant differences between the men with acute scrotal infection and the men without it.
