Escape from Freedom is a book by the Frankfurt-born psychoanalyst Erich Fromm, first published in the United States by Farrar & Rinehart in 1941 with the title Escape from Freedom and a year later as The Fear of Freedom in UK by Routledge & Kegan Paul. It was translated into German and first published in 1952 under the title ' Die Angst vor der Freiheit' (The Fear of Freedom).

If humanity cannot live with the dangers and responsibilities inherent in freedom, it will probably turn to authoritarianism. At this time Hitler had taken over much of continental Europe with the further objectives of conquering England and the Soviet Union.
