newborn will take from 2 to 3 ounces (60–90 mL) of formula per feeding and will eat every three to four hours on average during her first few weeks.(Breastfed infants usually take smaller, more frequent feedings than formula-fed infants). During the first few weeks: If your baby sleeps longer than four to five hours and starts missing feedings, wake ...

Subtract the free water supplied by the formula from the calculated total free water requirement. This equals the remaining volume of free water. How much should a newborn eat? Liquid intake. 2-3 fl oz (60-90 mL) every 3-4 hours (6-8 feedings/day) Tips. Look for an infant formula that has about 17 mg/100 kcal of Docosahexaenoic Acid (0.32% DHA).
