The first secret to gardening in a cold climate is to grow really hardy perennials, and there are a number of plants that are troopers no matter how harsh the winter or spring. As a general rule, those that die back to the ground each fall do better than evergreen perennials, although I have successfully overwintered both lavender (Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead') and sage (Salvia officinalis).

Cold frames are raised bed structures with a protective cover or glass where your plants can be better exposed to the sun. Raised beds are growing structure where the temperature is warmer than on the ground.

Protect plants: If you've not already done so, or are in a climate where winter sets in later, it's not too late to protect plants from cold winter temperatures. Cover newly planted trees and shrubs and established evergreens from frost and dehydrating winter winds with shrub covers or wrap them with burlap.

Cold weather, particularly frost, causes the water in plant cells to freeze, damaging the cell wall. Frost-damaged plants are easy to spot, their growth becomes limp, blackened and distorted.
