The Clan Donald Society of Edinburgh - Genealogy the founder of Clan Donald - literally "the children of Donald." His descen-dants and followers became "MacDonald." Also acknowledged as: "Lords of the Isles," Clan Donald ruled much of Scotland's western coast until King James IV removed the title - and much of the Clan's power - in 1493. The Isle of Skye has

been the seat of Clan Donald since the 1400s.

The Celtic law of rule by derbfine (Gaelic meaning 4 generations of family) is the reason Clan Donald was divided into sliochd or branches, each ruled by a descendant of Donald instead of the feudalistic concept of a united kingdom inherited by the eldest son. The Celtic way was to diffuse government into local kingdoms rather than have a powerful central government.

Clan Donald, also known as Clan MacDonald, is a Highland Scottish clan and one of the largest Scottish clans. The Lord Lyon King of Arms, who is the Scottish official with responsibility for regulating heraldry in that country, issuing new grants of coats of arms, and serving as the judge of the Court of the Lord Lyon, recognizes under Scottish law the High Chief of Clan Donald. Historically the chiefs of the Clan Donald held the title of Lord of the Isles until 1493 and two of those chiefs also

The Symbols of Clan Donald The symbols of Clan Donald include the Red Right Hand, The Rampant Lion, Clan Donald 's cross, The Celtic Galley, and The Salmon as displayed in the 19th century Somerled Window from Armadale castle as well as many of the wax seals that accompanied the signatures of Clan Donald chiefs for over 600 years.

Clan Donald Descendants The current Clan Chief is Godfrey James MacDonald of MacDonald, 8th Lord MacDonald. He became high chief of Clan Donald in 1970 and sits on the Board of Trustees of the Clan Donald Lands Trust. A recent scientific study suggests one in four MacDonalds can trace their origins back to the Norse-Celtic warrior King Somerled.

MacDonald Genealogy — Maternal Scottish Ancestors Clan MacDonald (or simply clan Donald) are a Highland clan - and historically the largest and most powerful, holding large areas of land in the Highlands. There are several MacDonald clan branches, most notably the MacDonalds of Sleat and MacDonalds of Clanranald. For many years the MacDonalds held the title of Lord of the Isles, claiming territory along the west cost of Scotland, until James IV of Scotland removed the title and

territory from the clan after fearing that they would overpower ...

A member of Clan Donald is anyone associated with and loyal to, but not necessarily a literal descendant of Donald, King of the Isles. In the Kingdom of the Isles, Clan Donald included those who fought and lived alongside Clan Donald. The Clan Donald Society of Edinburgh also backed this view.

The eponymous ancestor of Clan Donald is Donald, son of Reginald, son of Somerled. Somerled, son of Gillebride was a 12th century leader, styled as "king of the isles" and "king of Argyll", though his origins and ancestry are obscure. The Macdonalds of Clanranald descend from Donald's son, Angus Mor and then from his son, Angus Og.
