Guidelines on Person Centered Planning | The National ...

Person centred planning (PCP) provides a way of helping a person plan all aspects of their life, thus ensuring that the individual remains central to the creation of any plan which will affect them. Person centred planning is not an assessment. It should be about making changes in a person ' s life and planning for the future.

Person-centred planning (PCP) | Foundation for People with ...

Sections 24 and 25 of the Care Act 2014 outline that people should be in control of their support and should be actively involved in influencing their care and support. The act states that "the guiding principle in the development of the plan is that this process should be person-centred". One of the overarching principles of the guideline is that care and support should be person-centred and focused on recovery (recommendation 1.1.1).

1. Delivering services that are person-centred and focused ...

Providers must make sure that they take into account people's capacity and ability to consent, and that either they, or a person lawfully acting on their behalf, must be involved in the planning, management and review of their care and treatment.

A person centred planning process is conducted at least annually. This process feeds updates to the Support Plan. A person centred plan is developed with each person in advance or shortly (~3 months) after service begins. The organization monitors and is accountable for the commitments made during the planning process.
