Manual Handling Manual handling includes movements (lifting, pushing, pulling, holding, throwing, carrying) and repetitive tasks (packing, typing, assembling, cleaning, sorting, using tools and machinery). Unsafe manual handling can lead to sprains and strains, soft tissue injuries, back problems, hernias and chronic pain.

Manual Handling Poor manual handling is one of the most common causes of injury at work and accounts for more than one in five of all workplace injuries. Prevent strains, bad backs and torn muscles, through raised personal awareness of the way to handle goods and materials, avoiding costly absences due to injury.

Manual Handling - Health and Safety and Management ...

The Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992 are the main piece of legislation dealing with manual handling. It sets out the main duties for employers and employees. The order of controls contained within the regulation explain that first you need to avoid manual handling. When this is not possible you need to assess and reduce the risk.

Health and Safety Executive (HSE) Manual handling causes over a third of all workplace injuries. These include work-related musculoskeletal disorders (MSDs) such as pain and injuries to arms, legs and joints, and repetitive strain injuries of various sorts.
