After the burnings of a group in Orleans, France and another in Monteforte, Italy, heresy occurred in isolation in the 11th and 12th century, usually the product of a sole, charismatic preacher who wanted more spiritual churches, and when eradicated, the followers dispersed.

While the groups themselves ranged in beliefs, their commonality was their rejection of and peresecution by the Church.
