Pull the sails in as you head up or sail closer to the wind. Ease the sails out as you bear off or turn away from the wind. Mainsail Trimming in the mainsail is easy: you pull on the mainsheet, and the boom and sail move closer to the centerline of the boat. Jib The jib will usually have two sheets!one that runs down each side of the boat. To trim the jib, pull in the sheet farthest away from the wind!the leeward sheet.
