Conducting Interviews in Qualitative Social Science Research Types: ¥ individual face-to-face (choose non-shy participants willing to share) ¥ telephone (not ideal but used when direct access not possible) ¥ focus group (if time is limited, if interaction aids response, if solo participants hesitant)
