In the first millennium of the church, Junia was widely acknowledged to be a woman. It was not until the Middle Ages that Junia was made out to be a man’s name: Junias. The change appears to be arbitrary, but the idea that Junia was a man became even more prevalent with Martin Luther’s translation, eventually becoming the assumed norm.

The fact that Junia was “in Christ before I was” would make Junia one of the earliest Christians, since Paul had become a believer within three years of the resurrection ( Galatians 2 ). She may have even been in Jerusalem for Pentecost when Peter preached in Acts 2.

Yes, if Bauckham is right then Junia / Joanna is the first woman apostle along with Mary Magdalene, and perhaps Susanna. The first credible reference to Junia as male comes from Aegidius of Rome (ca. 1243-1316) in the late Middle Ages, though without explanation. Two centuries later, in 1512, Jacques LeFevre also considered her a man, even though in the Latin translation available to him the name was clearly feminine (37).

Whereas for John Chrysostom the apostle addressed by Paul is a woman by the name of Junia, for almost all modern scholars it is a man, Junias, whom Paul is greeting. The name "Junia" appears in Romans 16:7, and Paul identifies her (along with Andronicus) as "prominent among the apostles." In this important work, Epp investigates the mysterious disappearance of Junia from the traditions of the church. Because later theologians and scribes could not believe (or wanted to suppress) that Paul had numbered a woman among the earliest churches' apostles, Junia's name was changed in Romans to a masculine form.

Early church fathers, even those who had a bias against women in leadership, understood "Junia" to be a female apostle in the early church. Origin (185-284), who is known as the church's first systematic theologian, understood the name to be feminine as did the famous church father, Jerome (A.D. 347-420), who produced the Latin Vulgate Bible.
