HOMESCHOOL BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS Law Of Home Schooling
According to UK law, all parents have the right to educate their child at home. The Education Act does not define ‘efficient’ education, nor does it stipulate how many hours is considered ‘full-time’. As most children attend school for approximately 25 hours a week, parents and carers who home educate often use this as a guide.

HOMESCHOOLING A CHILD: As a parent, you can teach and educate your child at home - even if you are not a qualified teacher. In the United Kingdom, all children should receive a full-time education from the age of 5 years old. Home education rules have no legal requirement for parents to follow the national curriculum to the letter. But, you should follow all other child home schooling regulations.

Homeschool Laws By State

This means that by law, you have the right to teach your child at home, including if your child has special educational needs (SEN). You don’t need to be a teacher or have educational qualifications to home educate. You aren’t required to follow the national curriculum, and your child doesn’t have to take exams like SATs, GCSEs or A Levels.

Connecticut Law About Homeschooling

According to Missouri Homeschool Laws, you need to homeschool a minimum of 174 days in a year with 1000 hours of learning, designating the number of hours as follows: Six hundred hours a year for core subjects like English, Art, Science, language, mathematics, reading, and Social Studies.
