Gender Dysphoria: Overview, Management, Diagnosis, and More

For the last 10years, the management of gender dysphoria in children and adolescents has developed in several countries, specifically in Europe, but remains under-recognized in France. Since 2013, several pediatric psychiatry and endocrinology departments have initiated a multidisciplinary evaluation and management approach for these patients.

This topic covers the management of gender dysphoria in adults only. Gender dysphoria is not commonly pronounced

enough to prompt patients to seek medical intervention. Dual role transvestism is the most common manifestation. Most clinics treat patients with hormones only when they are adults and have already changed their social gender role (or, occasionally, have a definite and agreed time when they will do so).

Gender dysphoria in adults - Symptoms, diagnosis and ...

Some people with gender dysphoria, but not all, may want to use hormones and sometimes surgery to express their gender identity. Gender dysphoria is not a mental illness, but some people may develop mental health problems because of gender dysphoria. Signs of gender dysphoria. People with gender dysphoria may have changed their appearance, their behaviour or their interests. They may also show signs of discomfort or distress, including: low self-esteem

For most trans men, the aim of hormone therapy is to achieve serum testosterone levels equivalent to the adult male range, and in doing so simulate male puberty, a process that can take up to 5 years to complete.

Endocrine Management of Gender Dysphoria in Adults

Gender dysphoria in children does not necessarily persist into adulthood; indeed, studies suggest it only does so in 6-23%. If gender dysphoria persists then hormone treatment may be considered from the age of 16 years. Seamless transition to adult care services at the age of 18 years should be the norm if this is the case.

Gender Dysphoria. Information on gender dysphoria, info ...

It is important to have a basic understanding of how to conduct an initial consultation of gender dysphoria even if it is an uncommon presentation in general practice. Management should be individualised and may involve a combination of social work, education, counselling, hormone therapy and surgery.

In contrast to prior efforts to identify and primarily address underlying psychiatric contributors to gender dysphoria, interventions that include uncritical social affirmation, use of gonadotropin-releasing hormone agonists to suppress normally timed puberty, and administration of cross-sex steroid hormones to induce desired secondary sex characteristics are now advocated by an emerging cohort of transgender medicine specialists.
