Just over half of them do not occur in Evenson-II and even if you own both of Evenson’s books (Evenson-I being Mushrooms of Colorado and the Southern Rocky Mountains), plus Mushrooms of the Pacific Northwest and Jack States’s Mushrooms and Truffles of the Southwest, there would still be nearly 50 species that appear only in the new guide. Coverage includes seven amanitas, seven tricholomas, six corts, six russulas, six suilluses, six hygrophoruses, five calvatias, and five lactariuses.
