They serve, rather, as "models" for legal jurisdictions to utilize when developing statutes and regulations. The main purpose of building codes are to protect public health, safety and general welfare as they relate to the construction and occupancy of buildings and structures.

When the BCA is satisfied, it will issue a building consent for the work to proceed. If the work is built to the consented plans and receives a code compliance certificate, it confirms the requirements of the Building Code have been met. The Building Code is contained in regulations under the Building Act 2004.

Building Code compliance | Building Performance

When a building is used for more than one occupancy purpose, it shall be subject to the most restrictive requirements for the occupancies concerned: Except, - (1) When a one-story building houses more than one occupancy, each portion of the building shall conform to the requirements for the occupancy housed therein, and the area of the building shall be such that the sum of the actual areas divided by the allowable area for each separate occupancy shall not exceed one; and (2) Where minor ...

Vent Shafts. (a) Ventilation or vent shafts shall have a horizontal cross-sectional area of not less than 0.10 square meter for every meter of height of shaft but in no case shall the area be less than 1.00 square meter. No vent shaft shall have its least dimension less than 600 millimeters. (b) Skylights.

There must be two floors. The building must be seven meters high. As an example, if the plot is 15,000meters squared, the property must be no more than 300 meters squared. This means each of the two floors can be 300 meters squared bringing the total area to 600 meters squared.

Standards for damp-proof courses are provided in BS 8215:1991 Code of practice for design and installation of damp-proof courses in masonry construction. The absence of a damp-proof course in older buildings can be rectified by creating a moisture-impermeable layer
