The focus of primary care is to relieve the symptoms associated with the acute pain condition while increasing movement and functionality in the affected area. 26 In general, the psychological factors addressed in primary care settings correspond to alleviating any anxiety or fear associated with the occurrence of pain. At this phase, it is important to educate the patient about medication compliance and following the prescribed exercise protocol in order to expedite the healing process.

Psychosocial Factors in Musculoskeletal Disorders. Work-related musculoskeletal disorders (MSD) have a multifactorial etiology that includes not only physical stressors but also psychosocial risk factors, such as job strain, social support at work, and job dissatisfaction. Once an injury has occurred, psychosocial factors, such as depression and maladaptive pain responses, are pivotal in the transition from acute to chronic pain and the development of disability.
