When examining the interaction effect for sexual orientation and race/ethnicity, belonging to the "other" racial/ethnic group and being lesbian/gay had the highest OR for predicting suicidal ideation (OR=1.68; 95% CI=1.12 to 2.51) and for suicide attempt, being American Indian/Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander and bisexual had the highest risk (OR=2.44; 95% CI=1.75 to 3.41).

Data collected on mental health in minority ethnic groups can often be subject to small sample sizes, meaning our ability to look at mental health within a specific ethnic group is sometimes limited. Compared with whites, members of racial and ethnic minorities are less likely to receive preventive health services and often receive lower-quality care. They also have worse health outcomes for certain conditions.

In Focus: Reducing Racial Disparities in Health Care by ...

The relationship between SES, race and ethnicity is intimately intertwined. Research has shown that race and ethnicity in terms of stratification often determine a person's socioeconomic status (U.S. Census Bureau, 2009). Furthermore, communities are often segregated by SES, race, and ethnicity.
