A trailblazing marine biologist who sparked the modern environmental movement with Silent Spring (1962), Carson ' s lesser-known writings – Under the Sea-Wind (1941), The Sea Around Us (1951), The Edge of the Sea (1955) and the posthumously published The Sense of Wonder (1965) – encouraged her readers to consciously cultivate habits of awe, to pay careful attention to the often-overlooked ‘ beauties and mysterious rhythms of the natural world ’ . ‘ We look too hastily, ’ she lamented.
