Veterinary surgeons can perform intricate surgeries in the chest or abdomen, such as correction of congenital or acquire vascular abnormalities, trauma surgery, gastrointestinal or biliary rerouting, and urogenital reconstruction and stenting.

There is a surgical correction, however, that can help alleviate the problem. Tibial Plateau Leveling Osteotomy, or TPLO, is a procedure which puts the animal's knee joint back in proper alignment. During the surgery, the leg bones are cut and rotated to their proper positions and then stabilized using a metal plate and bone screws.

It is the most common problem with tissue expansion reconstruction. If you develop an infection you will need to rest and take antibiotics. Usually, this clears up the infection over a week or so. If you ' ve had implant reconstruction or tissue expansion and the infection continues, your surgeon might need to take the implant out.
