Again, the results of this evaluation were very positive, with virtually all outcomes we measured pre- and post-DART being statistically significant. For example, mothers had significantly better communication with their child, felt more supported in their roles as a parent, and more interested and involved in their child's lives.

Evaluating children's observations allows us to identify the children's strengths, interests and opportunities for further development. Interpreting an observation is not just writing a summary of a child's development, you are interpreting developmental skills, capabilities, potential, emerging interests and preferences.

How to write child observations, reflect and forward plan.

In social work practice all children and their families should be treated the same regardless of their colour, gender, race or religious beliefs. On reflection the observation was a learning curve ready for actual practice.
