The Subjective Truths In The

Subjective truth is similarly based on a person's beliefs but not all people may agree with it. This kind of truth is present in things like religion. One person may believe that the existence of God is the truth, where another person may not. People also form their own judgments of the truth of a situation based on the information they have.

The Difference between Objective and Subjective Truth ...

While objective truths are final and static, subjective truths are continuing and dynamic. The truth of one's existence is a living, inward, and subjective experience that is always in the process of becoming.

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Answer: Subjective truth, which is sometimes mistaken for relative truth, is a philosophical concept normally attributed to Danish philosopher Søren Kierkegaard (1813–1855). Kierkegaard believed that religious truth is a personal, not impersonal, thing—that it is something we are, not something we have. Kierkegaard acknowledged objective truth as being something “outward,” while believing that subjective truth is something “inward.”.

OBJECTIVE TRUTH: To say that a statement is “objectively true” means that it is true for people of all cultures, times, etc., even if they do not know it or recognize it to be true. Examples: “People need water and air to live.”. “Water freezes once it is chilled to a certain temperature.”. **SUBJECTIVE TRUTH:** To say that something is “subjectively true” means that it is true for the person (s) making the judgement, even though it may not be true for others.

A subjective point of view is characterised by the past experiences, knowledge, perceptions, understanding and desires of the specific person. These statements are exclusively based on the ideas or opinion of the person making it, as there is no universal truth.

Kierkegaard on the Subjective Nature of Truth. When we ask a question, the one thing we hope the answer will result in is the truth. Though somethings can be known, the reality of experience is that truth is often a slippery thing. Many philosophers have concerned themselves

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with this evasiveness, attempting to clarify in objective terms what can be known; this is the work of rational epistemology.

Kierkegaard on the Subjective Nature of Truth

If moral values are subjective, there can be no moral absolutes. If everything is subjective, then nothing is absolute. This would mean that if all moral choices depend upon individual desires, then nothing is by nature morally right or wrong. This would mean that nothing is right or wrong morally.

Subjectivity is a central philosophical concept, related to consciousness, agency, personhood, reality, and truth, which has been variously defined by sources. Three common definitions include that subjectivity is the quality or condition of: Something being a subject, narrowly meaning an individual who possesses conscious experiences, such as perspectives, feelings, beliefs, and desires.
