On November 10, 1903, the U.S. Patent Office awarded Patent No. 743,801 to a Birmingham, Alabama woman named Mary Anderson for her "window cleaning device for electric cars and other vehicles to remove snow, ice or sleet from the window.". This invention could clear snow, rain or sleet from the windshield of a car by using a handle inside the vehicle.
