Lectionary Sermon for June 22 2014, on Matthew 10:24-39. There are some passages in the Gospels that are just plain awkward and the first impression of today's passage from Chapter 10 in the gospel of Matthew is that it hardly fits the traditional artist's image of Gentle Jesus meek and mild. However, remembering that this Gospel first appeared some years after Jesus had faced crucifixion, this particular teaching passage would have had real meaning for the early converts.
