When a vasectomy is performed, your surgeon will reroute or clamp the internal tubing that carries sperm from the testical through the penis. During a vasectomy reversal, this tube is restored. Typically, the procedure takes two hours and you can return to work within 1-2 days. 2.

A vasectomy reversal procedure is a delicate surgery performed for men who have previously had a vasectomy. While a vasectomy is performed for permanent birth control, surgery can be done to help men become fertile again and father more children. During a vasectomy, the vas deferens (the tube that carries sperm from the testicle) is seperated.

For example, the more time that's passed since your vasectomy, the more scar tissue will have developed in the tubes that carry sperm to your penis. It's estimated that the success rate of a vasectomy reversal is: 75% if you have your vasectomy reversed within 3 years; up to 55% after 3 to 8 years; between 40% and 45% after 9 to 14 years; 30% after 15 to 19 years

### Can I get a vasectomy reversed? - NHS

Vasectomy reversal operations are more successful if they are done fairly soon after the original vasectomy. About 8 out of 10 men father children when their vasectomy is reversed within three years. If 15 years or more have passed since the vasectomy, this success rate falls to about 3 out of 10 men.

#### **All about vasectomy reversal surgery**

Vasectomy reversal is a term used for surgical procedures that reconnect the male reproductive tract after interruption by a vasectomy. Two procedures are possible at the time of vasectomy reversal: vasovasostomy (vas deferens to vas deferens connection) and vasoepididymostomy (epididymis to vas deferens connection).

The quality of the fluid is an important factor in the success of the reversal. So...clear or slightly milky fluid with whole sperm has a higher success rate than say creamy fluid and sperm parts. Having a sperm granuloma or testicles that just happened to protect the quality of sperm after a vasectomy, gives the patient a higher success rate.

#### **Vasectomy reversal and ... Luck? You bet! – Northeast ...**

A vasectomy reversal reconnects the severed vas deferens, the tube that carries sperm from each testicle. During a vasectomy reversal, the severed ends of the vas deferens are reattached to one another. In some cases, the vas deferens may be attached directly to the epididymis — the part of the testicle where sperm matures.

#### **Vasectomy reversal - Healthleech**

A vasectomy reversal can be accomplished, but the longer the time frame after the initial vasectomy, the lower the chances of success. Reversal success rates are 75% for patients 5 years or less removed from their vasectomy. That rate drops to approximately 40-50 % at 8 years, and to 30% or less after 10 or more years.

#### **Vasectomy Reversal - pacificsurgeryomaha.com**

Success rates for vasectomy reversal vary, but are usually about 50%. It can take up to 1 to 2 years after reversal surgery for pregnancy to occur. The time interval between the original vasectomy and the reversal procedure is the most important factor. The shorter the time between vasectomy and reversal, the better the chances for fertility recovery.
