Ivanhoe: A Romance (/ ?a?v?n?ho? /) by Walter Scott is a historical novel published in three volumes, in 1819, as one of the Waverley novels. At the time it was written, the novel represented a shift by Scott away from writing novels set in Scotland in the fairly recent past to a more fanciful depiction of England in the Middle Ages.

Subsequent novels appeared with the note by the author of Waverley; hence his novels often are called collectively the Waverley novels. In recognition of his literary work Scott was made a baronet in 1819.
