When writing a musical, you must figure out your premise, what your show is really about at its core. Once you define your premise, make sure that everything serves that premise – every character, every scene, every line, every song. Anything that does not serve the premise is extraneous and must be cut.

Most musical theater composers work with a team including a book writer and lyricist, who are collectively responsible for conceiving the show's story, writing the script, and connecting the story with the music via lyrics. However, some multidisciplinary composer-playwrights—like Lin-Manuel Miranda or Jonathan Larson—take the creative process a step further, overseeing every aspect of a new musical from start to finish: book, lyrics, and music.

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
