Give yourself enough time!

Ideally, you should have 4-6 months to plan, if not more (depending on the nature of your event) Be aware of statutory and religious holidays. Avoid school holiday time periods (winter, spring and summer holidays) Check dates with key participants – speakers, presenters, VIP guests, etc.

Whether it's your first event or your hundredth, event planning is stressful. And, when you need to make sure nothing slips through the cracks, there's this event checklist. Use it at any point of the event planning process to reduce stress and make sure no detail is forgotten.

How To Create a Foolproof Event Planning Checklist ...

Block off rows or sections of seating in order to space people at least 6 feet apart. Use multiple entrances and exits and discourage crowded waiting

areas. Eliminate lines or queues if possible or encourage people to stay at least 6 feet apart by providing signs or other visual cues such as tape or chalk marks.
